



8. PLANNING MATTERS

Rushcliffe Borough Council planning applications

16/02321/ful. Dawn Thatcher, 1 Conery Gardens, single storey extensions and alterations, render bungalow exterior, use of log cabin/summer house in connection with beauty treatment business. No objection.

Jenny Kirkwood of Royal Community Action Nottingham has been asked to look into possible funding assistance. The chairman spoke of the need to have an expert on board to help with the production of the actual report.
